Chair of the Voice Department at Berklee College of Music since 2011, she has helped to shape the College's reputation as the best place in the world to study singing.

Anne's popular master classes and vocal pedagogy seminars for vocalists embrace the foundations of vocal technique, while helping to build performance skills in rock, jazz, pop, and R&B music.

She is the author of two highly successful voice instruction books: *The Contemporary Singer, Elements of Vocal Technique*, and *Vocal Workouts for the Contemporary Singer*, both of which include professional practice tracks. Anne Peckham is also the author of the popular Berklee Music online course, *Voice 101*.
